

- The country's official name is the Republic of the Philippines
- The country's Capital is Manila
- English and Filipino are the country's two officially recognized languages
- Rodrigo Duterte is the current President of Philippines
- The Philippines was the first country in Southeast Asia to gain independence after World War II, in 1946.
- The national symbol of the Philippines is the monkey-eating eagle. It is the largest of all eagles and was declared the national bird of the Philippines in 1995
- The Philippines has a population of more than 100 million people, which makes it the 12th most populous country in the world.
- The Philippines has the highest rate of discovery of new animal species with 16 new species of mammals discovered just in the last 10 years

Fun Facts

- The Philippines are named after King Philip II of Spain.
- San Fernando, Philippines, is known as the "Christmas Capital of the Philippines" and is most famous for its parols (giant Christmas lanterns), which symbolize the star of Bethlehem and can rise 20 feet (6 m) in the air.
- The Philippines comprises of more than 7,000 islands.
